Introduction

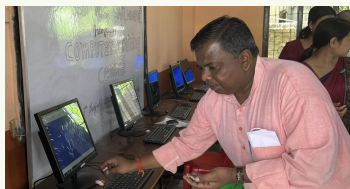
Inauguration of Skill Development Center

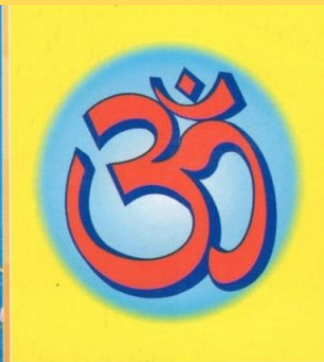
