Organized During 2023-24

### SHANTANU RAGHUNATH SHENDE AWARD 2022

The "Shantanu Raghunath Shende Award" for the year 2022 was announced on April 23, 2023, during the Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra Annual General Body Meeting. Dr. Jagadindra Ray Choudhury, Secretary of Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra, revealed the awardee, and the award was presented by Shri Avnish Bhatnagar, All India General Secretary of Vidya Bharati, to Mrs. Vashudha Bhide, the Principal of Saraswati Vidya Niketan, Mahadevpur, Arunachal Pradesh. Mrs. Bhide was honored for her tireless efforts and significant contributions to the field of education.



### KSHETRIYA YOGA AND CHESS COMPETITION

Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra organized a Yoga and Chess competition at Shankardev Shishu Vidya Niketan in Sonapur from August 11 to 13, 2023. To mark this milestone, Kshetriya Chintan Baithaks have been organized at 15 different locations across the country. These meetings aim to review Vidya Bharati's progress and to develop an action plan for the next decade. Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra's 3-day Chintan Baithak was held at the Shillong campus of Central Agricultural University, Manipur, from August 25 to 27, 2023. The meeting concluded under the guidance of Akhil Bharatiya Organizing Secretary, Govind Chandra Mahant. During the Chintan Baithak, participants engaged in detailed discussions on various topics including Indian education philosophy, school quality development, student and teacher development, education in mother tongue, skill development, social responsibility, the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020, and education in rural, tribal, border, coastal, and remote mountainous areas. The Baithak



comprised of 36 members from the northeastern states. ### SEMINAR ON NARRATIVE

The Vidwat Parishad organized a lecture on “Contemporary Narratives in Education” at Sankardev Vidya Niketan, Bishnupath, on April 25, 2023. The event was attended by prominent figures including Shri Avanish Bhatnagar, Hon'ble General Secretary of Vidya Bharati; Dr. Parimal Bhattacharya, President of Vidwat Parishad; Dr. Jagadrindra Ray Choudhury, Kshetriya Secretary; Dr. Smriti Kumar Sinha, Coordinator of the program and honorable VC of Pragjyotishpur University and Dr. Pawan Tiwari, Kshetriya Organizing Secretary. In his keynote address, Bhatnagar Ji emphasized the need to change not only textbooks but also mindsets to appreciate India's vast knowledge tradition. He highlighted that the National Education Policy 2020 aims to revive India's ancient cultural glory by focusing on the contributions of great Indian figures and the research of Vidya Bharati. Bhatnagar criticized the historical influence of Mecauley's education system, which he claimed aimed to produce Indians who were mentally subservient to British ideals, weakening Indian thought and culture. He called for a collective effort to shape public opinion positively and establish India as a leading nation.

The Shishu Vatika Acharya Training programme was held at SSN Beltola in Guwahati from July 3rd to 9th, 2023. ## **HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST THREE YEARS ACTIVITIES**

### **FORMATION OF SERF**

To foster an academic atmosphere conducive to higher education in the Northeast region, Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra (VBPK) initiated the formation of a trust. Consequently, the Shankardev Education & Research Foundation (SERF) was registered on September 7, 2021, in Guwahati. The trust aims to fulfill the aspirations for quality higher education while instilling Bhartiya life values in students. The primary objective of SERF is to serve as a transformative agent engaged in education policy advocacy, institution building, and the creation of knowledge leaders. SERF's initiatives and activities are designed to position Bharat as a knowledge-based society. The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has provided SERF with an opportunity to emerge as a frontrunner in leading the Northeast in the implementation of NEP 2020.

### **NORTH-EAST EDUCATION CONCLAVE**

The Shankardev Education & Research Foundation (SERF) organized a two-day North-East Education Conclave on November 20-21, 2021, in Guwahati. The event aimed to discuss the NEP 2020, its implementation challenges, and experiences from various states. It featured 14 sessions, including plenary and parallel sessions for different educational groups. Over 1,000 delegates from 41 central universities, 57 state universities, 53 schools, and many NGOs participated. Keynote addresses were delivered by prominent figures, including Prof. D. P. Singh, Chairman of UGC and other notable guests such as Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, and Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Gol. Additionally, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi hon'ble Governor of Assam and Dr Ranoj Pegu, hon'ble Education Minister of Assam, Prof. Narendra Kumar Taneja, Secretary, Vidya Bharati Uchcha Shiksha Sansthan were also present in the sessions. The conclave, one of the largest in recent years in Northeast India, saw active participation from education ministers of northeastern states and resource persons from esteemed institutions. Discussions focused on revitalizing the education system per NEP 2020, emphasizing the preservation of indigenous culture alongside modern educational tools.

### **PRAGJYOTISHPUR UNIVERSITY**

Under the banner of Shankardev Education & Research Foundation (SERF) one and only university Pragjyotishpur University was formed. Honouring the rich and vibrant legacy associated with this name, Pragjyotishpur University came into being on Monday, the 17th of October 2022, with the enactment of the Pragjyotishpur University Act No. XLVI of 2022 by the Government of Assam. Pragjyotishpur University was founded with a resolve to nurture a center of world-class education and research driven by a cross-cutting approach for overcoming barriers to knowledge creation, sustenance and dissemination.



## **FORMATION OF TRIPURA JANAJATI SHIKSHA SAMITY**

To enhance academic activities among the Janajati communities in Tripura, the Tripura Janajati Shiksha Samity was established. This organization was formed on August 1, 2022, in the presence of Dr. Pawan Tiwari, Organizing Secretary of Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra and Dr. Jagadindra Ray Choudhury, Secretary of Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra.

## **10 DAYS TOUR PROGRAMME**
